Searching for opportunities

The public sector is required by law to publish opportunities publicly on portals such as the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU), or Contracts Finder (pre-leaving the European Union). From 01 January 2021 Find a Tender replaces this. Other than this, the regulations will not change dramatically following leaving the EU.

In terms of searching, it is worth mentioning that there are many organisations who will, for a fee, search for and send you tendering opportunities. However, if you don't want a paid for service, and you have a dedicated person in your business who can own this then here are some key online portals to register with and check regularly.



Tenders Electronic Daily “TED”

Supplement to the Official Journal of the EU and compendium of all public sector tenders in Europe. Use the 'advanced search' to narrow your focus.

Sold as 'your single source solution for public sector tenders' they provide both free and paid for tender alert services. Supplier registration is free.

You can register and search opportunities UK wide, for free. They also offer alert and searching services for a fee.

A professional Buying Organisation (PBO) managed by six member authority councils – Leicestershire, Lincolnshire, Cambridgeshire, Norfolk, Warwickshire and Peterborough. Worth registering with, especially if your business supplies these areas.

Publicly owned by 13 local authorities, including York, Bradford, and Rotherham they support UK wide local authorities to buy better. You can register and search for opportunities through their Proactis portal.

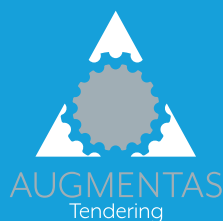
A gov.uk portal to search for opportunities UK wide – you don't even have to register to search.
